1.0 GREETINGS FROM YMCA COMPREHENSIVE INSTITUTE.

2.0 ON LINE LECTURES

All our students were encouraged to attend on line lectures and to access notes through the **YCI e-learning platform,** this enabled us complete the curriculum in time and this was followed with the intensive physical lectures in the month of November & December 2021. We advise that students are provided with a smart phone or laptop to enable them attend on line lectures on e learning platform in future.

3.0 END OF QUARTER EXAMS

The end of quarter examinations has been successfully conducted for the classes that completed their syllabus in time. The new students have done tests and their examinations will be conducted next quarter. The rest of the other students' results will be posted online by **Mon, 10**th**Jan, 2022.**

4.0 VACCINATION OF COVID 19

Following the Presidential address and the Ministry of Health guidelines on opening of Universities and tertiary Institutions in October 2021, it was mandatory to get all our stake holders vaccinated to control the spread of Covid 19. We wish to inform you that 98% of our staff were vaccinated with some students. It is on this background that we advise and urge the students to get vaccinated and obtain a valid **Covid 19 Vaccination Certificate** which will be mandatory and will be used to access the Institute premises from next year 2022.

5.0 INTERNSHIP FOR FINALIST

It is compulsory to all finalists in all courses to carry out internship apart from elementary programs and a fee **shs.** 100,000/= is added to the tuition fee in the final quarter. Those who go beyond the gazetted areas i.e **Mpigi, Luwero, Lugazi, Kayunga** and **Wakiso** will be required to pay an extra fee. The details can be obtained from the Bursar's office, and an official receipt should be obtained for any payments made.

6.0 QUARTERLY TESTS

Mid- quarterly tests will run from **Monday**, **28**th **February**, **2022**. All students are reminded to have cleared **at least 70%** of their tuition and Hostel fees (where applicable) to be eligible to sit for the tests. A fee of **shs. 20,000**/= will be charged for late registration effective **4**th **March**, **2022**. Full tuition payment (100%) is expected by **Monday**, **21**st **March**, **2022**. Students are advised to obtain a **financial statement and statements of results** to enable them know their academic performance.
