

3.0 E – LEARNING PROGRAMME

We wish to inform our students that online learning is continuing for all courses and we urge non finalist students to spare time and attend to these lectures. We also request our parents to provide the necessary equipment and facilitation to our learners to enable them continue with studies on line as a way of controlling the spread of Covid 19. Please always check on the e learning platform for more updated communication. E-learning will attract a payment of **shs. 50,000/=** for **Diploma & Certificate** programs.

Note: Project / course work on e learning platform will carry 30% of the total mark. Mean while the finalists continue with normal lectures.

4.0 INTERNSHIP

The continuing finalist (Quarter 6) will carry out internship after their final exams and a fee of **shs 100,000**/= due for transport costs which has doubled, is added to the tuition fee.

5.0 QUARTERLY PROJECT & COURSE WORK

We wish to remind all students that course work and project work will be submitted between **Monday**, **30**th **Nov**,- **Wed 2**nd **Dec**, **2020** through e-learning program and students should send their work using departmental emails. Those who will be attending lectures may hand in a hard copy.

6.0 RESEARCH

All Diploma students in quarter 5 are expected to do research at a supervision fee of **shs. 40,000**/= which will have to be paid.
